This temple is one among a cluster of eighteen medieval era large Hindu temples in the Kumbakonam area. The temple is dedicated to Shiva.
- Sri Mahalingeswarar Temple** (Distance: 9.3 km)
It's a Hindu temple dedicated to the deity Shiva, located in Tiruvidaimaruthur, a village in the South Indian state of Tamil Nadu.
- Maha Mham Tank** (Distance: 1.2 km)
It's a huge temple tank located in Kumbakonam. It is considered to be the foremost and one of the largest temple tanks in Tamil Nadu.

- Sarangapani Temple** (Distance: 2 km)
It's a Hindu temple dedicated to Vishnu, located in Kumbakonam, Tamil Nadu, India. It is one of the Divya Desams, the 108 temples of Vishnu revered in Nalayira Divya Prabandham by the 12 poet saints, or Alwars.
